The Field and Service Robotics (FSR) conference is a single track conference with a specific focus on field and service applications of robotics technology. The typical applications include mining, agriculture, building and construction, forestry, cargo handling and so on. Field robots may also operate on the ground (of Earth or planets), under the ground, underwater, in the air or in space. Service robots are those that work closely with humans, importantly the elderly and sick, to help them with their lives.

Paper Submissions

We invite papers describing original work in a number of technical areas related to field and service robotics. A book version of the Conference Proceedings will be published by Springer-Verlag in their STAR series and selected field robotics papers will be considered for publication in a Special Issue of the Journal of Field Robotics.
